Thank you so much for your generous donation of Euro 4000/- to Jesu Ashram's Leprosy department. It is donors like you that keeps encouraging Jesu Ashram's service and help to Leprosy affected people by providing them nursing cares, food, medicine, accommodation, psychological and spiritual support to live a dignified life.

In Jesu Ashram Leprosy section, Last year 301 patients were admitted, among them 4 were children. Unfortunately, 5 indoor patients died, three of them were buried in Jesu Ashram because they were destitute. We try to save every bit of limbs of Leprosy patients but 2 patients were amputated below the knees. In care of patients 427 ulcers were cleaned and dressed. In the especial drive for eye care for leprosy patients our doctors examined 74 of Leprosy affected people and 14 of them had cataract operation. They are given spectacles. In the weekly outdoor Leprosy clinic 1902 people were provided services. Among them 126 were minors. Under the weekly clinic 108 patients were in leprosy treatments of which 5 were children. The new case number of the Leprosy is 46. The Leprosy affected people coming from very far is a sign of needs for the help and service of Leprosy patients. To enable Jesu Ashram to continue this mission we look forward for your support in the coming years.
